NOTABLE PERFORMERS

Bri Monahan Becomes All-Time Leading Scorer at Gustavus - Bri Monahan (Sr., Hutchinson, MN) scored 19 points in Saturday's victory over Hamline and moved into the top spot in the Gustavus all-time scoring list. Entering the contest, Monahan needed 15 points to tie Linn Erickson (1,399 points from 1983 to 1987). Fifty seconds into the second half, Monahan made a layup to break the 20-year old record held by Erickson. Monahan currently sits at 1,403 points.

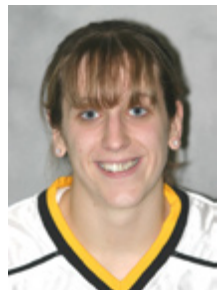
Trevor Wittwer and Bri Monahan Earn Academic All-District Honors - Trevor Wittwer (Jr., Redwood Falls, Minn.), a health fitness/pre-chiropractic major with a grade-point average of 3.91, was selected for the second consecutive year to the Academic All-District Second Team. Wittwer is third in the MIAC with a field goal percentage of 60.1 percent. Bri Monahan (Sr., Hutchinson, Minn.) is a studio art major with a 3.60 grade-point average. Monahan ranks second in the MIAC in scoring with an average of 17.0 points per game, fifth in steals with 2.4 per game, and ninth in free-throw percentage at 76.1 percent.

Matt Stewart Named by Swimming-WorldMagazine.com as National Swimmer of the Week - Matt Stewart (So., Burnsville, Minn.) was selected as the top male collegiate swimmer among all Division I, Division II, and Division III swimmers by setting school records in the dual meet against UW-Stevens Point. Stewart set records in the 200 butterfly with a time of 1:54.07 (The old record was 1:54.96), the 500 freestyle with a time of 4:39.16 (The old record was 4:44.19), and the 200 IM with a time of 1:56.17 (The old record was 1:58.95).



Jesse Brauer, a senior tennis player from Mankato, MN, defeated Tim Eisele of Wisconsin-Eau Claire at first singles 6-0, 6-1. Brauer teamed up with Ben Tomasek to beat Eisele and Steve Lantz 8-4 at first doubles. Brauer is

10-6 this season in singles matches and 5-5 at doubles.



Jess Vadnais, a junior guard from Hudson, WI, led Gustavus in scoring with 22 points in Wednesday's win over St. Thomas. In Saturday's win against Hamline Vadnais racked up 25 points. Combined she was 13-of-22 from the field, 6-of-11 from the

three-point land, and was nearly perfect from the free-throw line at 15-of-16.



Molly Doyle, a junior forward from Eagan, MN, posted the game-winning goal and two assists Friday evening against Augsburg and recorded an assist the following night. Doyle is tied for the team lead in goals with 12, despite playing in only 12 games.

She only needs one point to become the eighth player at Gustavus with a 100-point career.



Phil Sowden, a senior post from Brooklyn Park, MN, recorded a double-double in Wednesday's upset over No. 3 St. Thomas by scoring 16 points and pulling down 10 rebounds. Sowden led Gustavus with 20 points in Saturday's losing

effort to Hamline. He has scored double-digit figures in nine of the last ten games.
