\$2.5 MILLION

We will raise \$2.5 million to ensure that at least 200 fully endowed scholarships are created to assist families who would not otherwise be able to afford the cost of camp. These include scholarships for our vibrant summer camps; and for our intimate winter retreat camps. which bring urban and rural players and chaperones together to have a dialogue on race, gender, the future. religious diversity, and diverse family structure, to introduce students to the opportunities and benefits of a college education.

WILKINSON TENNIS COMPLEX RENOVATION FUND: \$500,000

We will raise \$500,000 to replace the Swanson Tennis Center bubble and to remodel the inside lobby, all the classrooms, and the public spaces of the tennis center. At the end of this process, all Gustavus tennis facilities (Brown and Gibbs outdoor courts, Swanson indoor courts, and any future additions) will be named the Wilkinson Tennis Complex.
