Heidi and I just attended the regional health advisor conference and went to sessions on admission policy during COVID. One thing that was mentioned and encouraged was [VIRTUAL SHADOWING](#). Some virtual shadowing options below.

[Medical School HQ eShadowing](#)

Dr. Gray's eShadowing is a free opportunity for students with robust attendance tracking and quizzes so that you can receive a certificate to document your hours. They have separate sessions for premeds with physicians and pre-PA students with PAs. Pre-PA eShadowing takes place every Monday at 7 pm ET and premed eShadowing is every Monday at 8 pm ET, with replays available through Sunday night. eShadowing will bring you physicians and PAs who will talk about their profession, offer a case presentation, and give their time for Q&A.

[HEAL Clinical Education Network](#)

HEAL offers free virtual shadowing every Wednesday night at 8pm EST. Watch real patients describe their symptoms as a doctor leads you through the process of note-taking, testing, diagnosis, and treatment. This LIVE course is held via Zoom and features interactive questions and answers to keep you engaged. HEAL also provides a certificate to document hours completed.

[Virtual Shadowing](#)

Free eShadowing sessions are held each Tuesday night at 7:00 pm CST with a ZOOM meeting over various topics. Certificates are provided upon completion of a quiz.

[Webshadowers](#)

Webshadowers provides free weekly virtual shadowing with MD/DO physicians. Times vary depending on availability. The quizzes required for verification for hours are only available for 30 minutes after each session, and the sessions are not recorded.
