Fall 2025 application details

The PharmCAS application for Fall 2025 admission is scheduled to open on July 11. U of MN <u>application deadlines</u>

Priority deadline - November 1, 2024 Final deadline - March 3, 2025

PharmD prerequisite updates

We recently made changes to our PharmD prerequisite requirements, which will be effective for 2025 applicants and beyond!

The changes include:

- Removal of the advanced biology, physics and communication prerequisites
- Expansion of the calculus prerequisite to include any collegelevel calculus, such as calculus I, applied calculus, or survey of calculus
- Change from an advanced English composition course to an introductory college-level composition (writing) course; course must be taken in English
- Expansion of the social & behavioral sciences to include humanities courses

 The non-math/science prerequisites (social & behavioral science / humanities and composition) may now be fulfilled with an associate's or bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited U.S. institution or completion of the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (previously only a bachelor's degree fulfilled)

Please note that these changes are ONLY for the University of Minnesota College of Pharmacy. The U of MN prerequisite website will soon be updated to reflect these changes. The U of MN guides of approved prerequisites available on our website will be updated midsummer. *Once the U of MN guides are updates our Gustavus website will be updated as well.
