Things to consider for CNA training:

Community College: Hours/schedule are more full-time in nature and college credit is also award along with certification. Therefore, cost might be higher for credit/certification.

Other organization: (Examples Thro Company-Mankato or Red Cross) Course offerings tend to be more part-time in nature to accommodate working/students schedules. Cost might also be slightly lower because of no academic credit earned.

Location: South Central- North Mankato

Credits: 4 credits

HCTC 1886 - Basic Nursing 101 (CNA)

Description: This course meets federal and state criteria for eligibility to take the state test to become a NAR, HHA, as well as the requirements for Basic Nursing 101, a requirement for the Practical Nursing Program. It introduces concepts of basic human needs, the health/illness continuum and focuses on preparing the student to safely perform basic nursing skills needed to function as a Nursing Assistant or Home Health Aide. (Prerequisites: None)

- if you are a student nurse or graduate nurse candidate. You must take the NA written and skills evaluation tests.
