

### Final Reflection Paper

In this paper, you will reflect upon your project as a whole, through the lens of *course concepts*. Think about how you could effectively articulate what you have learned about public discourse, civic engagement, and leadership as a result of this project. This paper should address your personal and intellectual growth from completing a significant semester-long civic engagement project.

The following questions should guide the development of your paper. Use specific examples to illustrate your points. Keep in mind where you will be asked these questions in the future—a job application/interview, a graduate school application, or a scholarship application.

- Describe at least three insights you gained about public advocacy, civic engagement, and/or leadership. Connect these insights to course content and your project. How did you succeed in civic engagement and leadership? Where did you fail? How did you adapt to circumstances and challenges?
- Describe at least three skills you discovered and developed this semester. What did you learn that you do well? What did you learn that you would like to improve upon? (See B 31.)
- How will you hone these skills in the future? Be specific about what you will do over the next few years. (See B 32.)
