#### Whatta Melon Pop!

#### Ingredients:

- 1 cup strawberry sorbet
- 2 teaspoons mini chocolate
- -3 tablespoons water
- -1/2 cup lemon sorbet
- -2 drops green food coloring
- -Wedge-shaped popsicle molds
- -Popsicle sticks



#### Instructions:

- 1. Mash together strawberry sorbet, mini chocolate chips, and 2 tablespoons water in a small bowl.
- 2. Put the mixture into wedge-shaped Popsicle molds (we used six 2-ounce molds), filling each about two-thirds full.
- 3. Spoon a thin, even layer of lemon sorbet on top. In a small bowl, stir together 1/2 cup lemon sorbet, 2 drops green food coloring, and 1 tablespoon water.
- 4. Spoon a layer into each mold and insert a Popsicle stick. Freeze for at least four hours.

### Summer Ideas: Gardening!

Get kids involved in a fun summertime activity. They'll get to learn where the food they eat comes from and have a great time digging, planting, eating, and learning.

\* Depending on the family, one can grow plants in a garden, a small container (for smaller children), a box plant (shown on the right), etc

#### Directions:

- -Decide what vegetables, herbs or flowers to grow
- -Pick a place that will get a good amount of sunlight, has moist soil, and will have good access to water
- -Dig a small hole; plant seed.
- -Follow instructions and water at the same time everyday
