Site Descriptions

Headstart: (daytime hours) Work with preschoolers (ages 3 and 4) in classroom setting. Different jobs include reading and playing with children, assisting with crafts, helping teachers, etc.

South Elementary: (daytime hours) Work with pre- kindergarden through second grade. You may work one to one with children or in a classroom setting assisting the teacher and students with various tasks and special projects.

Adult Basic Education: (evening hours) Work with classroom teachers, tutor adults who are working on improving basic reading and math skills or who are working toward their GED's.

St Peter Middle and High School: (daytime hours) Work with grades 7-12. Tutoring students who need help in specific subjects.

North Intermediate: (daytime hours) Work with third, fourth, fifth, and sixth graders. Gustavus volunteers will assist teachers in the classroom or work one to one with students, helping with homework or tutoring in specific subjects.

Discovery Days: (daytime hours) Work with preschoolers (ages 3 and 4) in a classroom setting. Different jobs include reading and playing with children, assisting with crafts, helping teachers, etc.

ELL (English Language Learners): (daytime and evening hours) Practice English conversation, vocabulary, etc. with middle, high school and adult English Language Learners.

South After School Student Support: (afternoon hours) Work individually with first and second students on math and reading skills after school; help facilitate computer-based math and reading time.
