CONTEST RULES AND CRITERIA

Contest Criteria

- Submissions should be written based on the following prompt:
 - Please address the question: *“Where do you hope your second language skills will take you, and how do you plan on getting there?”* We are looking for you to explore and reflect on what you hope to be able to do with the language in the future, and also importantly, how you will reach that goal.
- **The deadline for submission is Sunday, December 10, 2017 at 11:59pm. (Central Time)**
- For each entry, the following must be completed and received by the above deadline:
 - ✓ A digital or physical copy of the completed *Official Entry and Release form*.
 - ✓ A digital copy of your essay submission in an editable format such as Word.
 - ✓ A physical printout of your essay or a digital copy in PDF form.
- Eligible participants include all current students of Gustavus Adolphus College. Students not submitting entries will be selected to act as judges in the contest.
- Entries must be written in English, and should have a word count around 300-1200 words.

Prizes

- First Prize: **\$100**
- Second Prize: **\$25** and Book Mark physical prize(s) valuing up to \$20
- Please note: winnings are considered taxable income and prizes may or may not be available for pick up before the end of the semester.

Judging

- Entries will be judged with a special emphasis on the demonstration of thought behind the HOW aspect of the question, while still maintaining a cohesive essay.
- We are expecting collegiate level writing, so please put forth your best work. While grammar is not a main consideration, it may specifically be considered in judging between two similarly qualified essays.
- The prize winners will be decided by one or more judges to be decided at the discretion of the Director of the Culpeper Language Learning Center.

Other Information

Unforeseen situations (or situations that have not been discussed herein) related to contest criteria, prizes, judging, and other situations, will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis.
