The sanctions above are standard for the offenses listed, the College reserves the right to adjust the sanctions at the discretion of the hearing officer depending on the specifics of the incident and a student's conduct history. Non-cooperation during confrontation could result in increased sanctions.

NOTE: Confiscation of drugs and/or paraphernalia may occur and may warrant a search by Campus Safety and/or arrest or other action by law enforcement. If a student possesses items which could be used for the consumption of either legal or illegal substances, the Appropriate Student Conduct Authority will consider multiple factors in deciding whether or not those items are to be considered "Drug Paraphernalia" for the purposes of this policy. These factors could include but are not limited to: presence/odor of an illegal substance on the item(s) or in the nearby vicinity or physical signs of use of an illegal substance.

Sanctions resulting from marijuana violations are cumulative over the course of a student's enrollment. Students hosting non-Gustavus guests are responsible for ensuring their guests' compliance with all College policies.

Drug Education programs include **Marijuana 101** (an online module) and **CASICS: C**annabis **S**creening and **I**ntervention for **C**ollege **S**tudents, including a screening tool and two individual sessions with a trained facilitator to help students identify patterns of chemical use and how to reduce associated risks from their use in the future.
