Students living in Norelius, North, Gibbs, Sorensen, Uhler, Rundstrom, Southwest Hall Suites, Sohre, Pittman, Carlson International Center and Prairie View, will need to select one of the following (3) meal plans, (the cost of each plan includes a \$275.00/semester facilities staff and administrative support fee which is assessed at the beginning of each semester.):

Please chose Option 1, Option 2, or Option 3. Options are billed in two installments along with Fall and Spring Semester tuition.

Option 1 – \$3830.00 per year. This option is for the student who may be a lighter eater. This student may be away from campus many weekends.

Option 2 – \$4130.00 per year. This option is for the student who may be on campus daily, but does not eat three meals a day. This student may be away from campus some weekends.

Option 3 – \$4330.00 per year. This option is for the student who will be on campus daily. This student may be involved in athletics, or require a higher caloric intake for another reason.

Options 1, 2, and 3 student meal accounts will be credited monthly allocations in September, October, November, March, April, and May with the amount determined by the number of service days in the month. Up to \$20.00 may be carried forward from month to month and students who go over the monthly allocation will automatically move into the next month's balance. January and February will be allocated together as fees for January are included in the Fall and Spring billing cycles. Up to \$40.00 may be carried forward from January and February allocations and will automatically move into March's balance.

- All meal plan options are **a la carte**. What you put on your tray is what you pay for.
- Grab and Go items are more expensive, you may want to limit those types of purchases.
- Meal plan funds can be used in the Market Place, Courtyard Café, and The STEAMery.

Making changes to your Meal Plan Option:

Changes to **increase** your Meal Plan Option may be made in the Student Accounts Office at any time.

Changes to **lower** your Meal Plan Option for Spring 2021, must be made in the Student Accounts Office by December 4, 2020.

*Transactions made without sufficient funds in a declining balance account will be charged to the student's account on a monthly basis.

*Students who leave the college prior to the end of the semester may be eligible for a refund of 35% pro-rated to the last date of attendance.

*All Student Meal Plan transactions must be made with 3-Crown's Proximity Card. Lost or broken cards may be replaced in the Dining Service Office.

Student meal plans will be activated on September 4, 2020 and will end on May 22, 2021.
