CHRISTMAS IN CHRIST CHAPEL has become an eagerly awaited Holiday season tradition at Gustavus Adolphus College in the time since it was first held in 1973. For this tenth celebration, more than 5500 parents, friends, and members of the Gustavus community will attend the four services. About 300 students, representing six of the College's twenty musical organizations, are participating in Christmas in Christ Chapel '82.

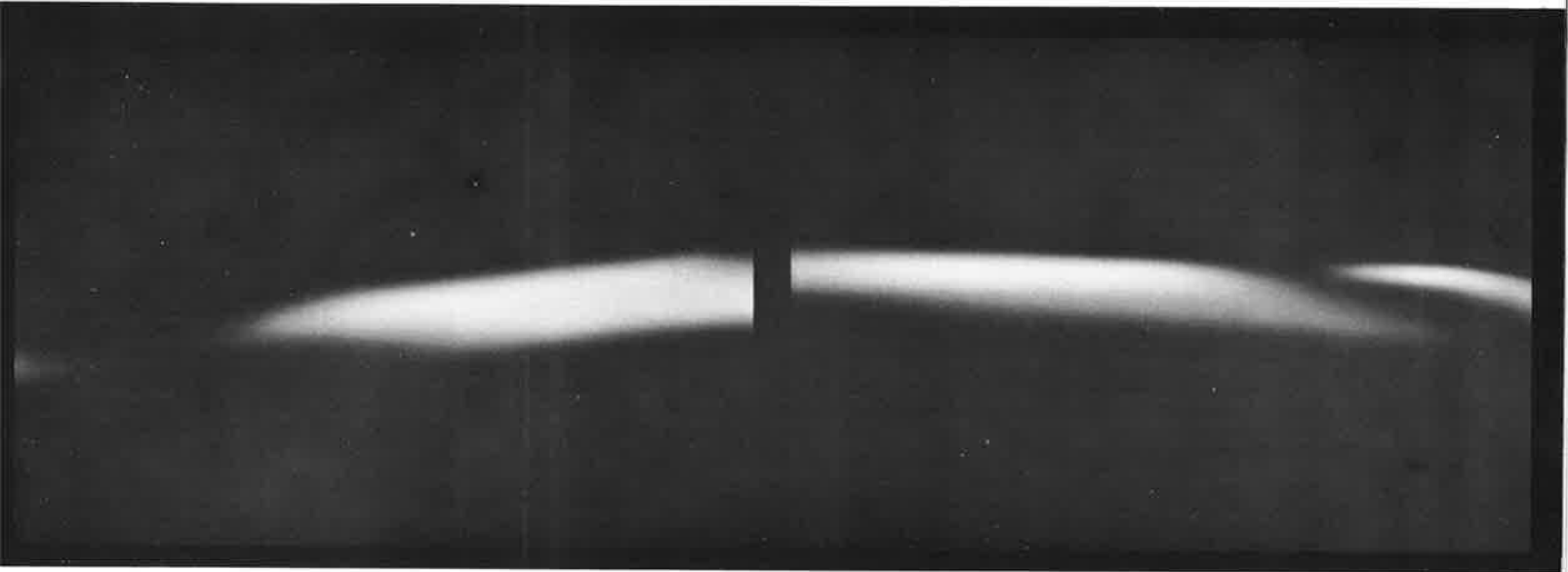
Musical organizations and music education are integral parts of the liberal arts curriculum at Gustavus Adolphus College. The College offers a major in music with four different emphases: general studies, church music, performance, and music education. Organizations such as the Gustavus Choir, the Gustavus Band, and the Gustavus Stage Band have traveled extensively and earned international acclaim.

Founded in 1862 by a Swedish immigrant pastor, Gustavus Adolphus College is today a fully accredited, coeducational liberal arts college affiliated with the Lutheran Church in America. Some 2300 students, representing more than forty states and several foreign countries, make up the student body. The faculty includes more than 150 full-time members, most of whom have earned the doctorate or terminal degree in their respective fields. A Bachelor or Arts degree may be earned with a major in any of 24 traditional disciplines, distributive and area studies, or pre-professional programs. Gustavus has earned a distinguished academic reputation—ninety percent of its students were graduated in the upper third of their high school classes and the school has a local chapter of Phi Beta Kappa and is a member of the National Association of Schools of Music.

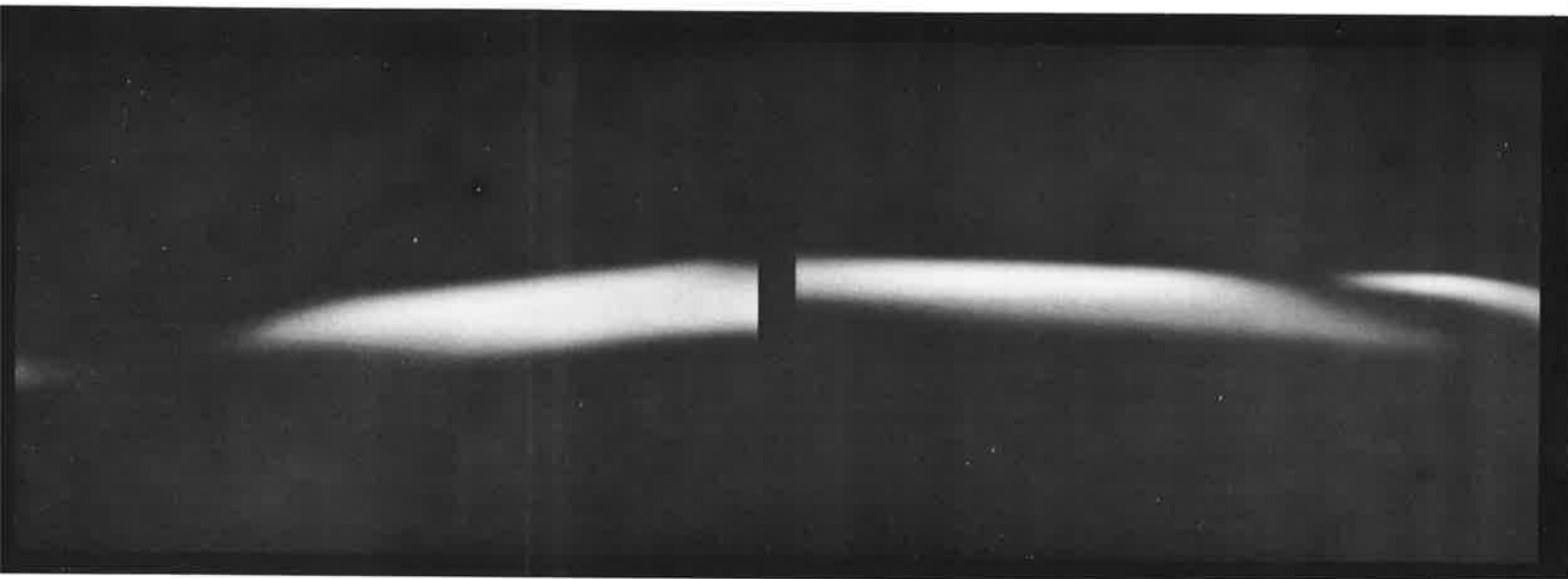

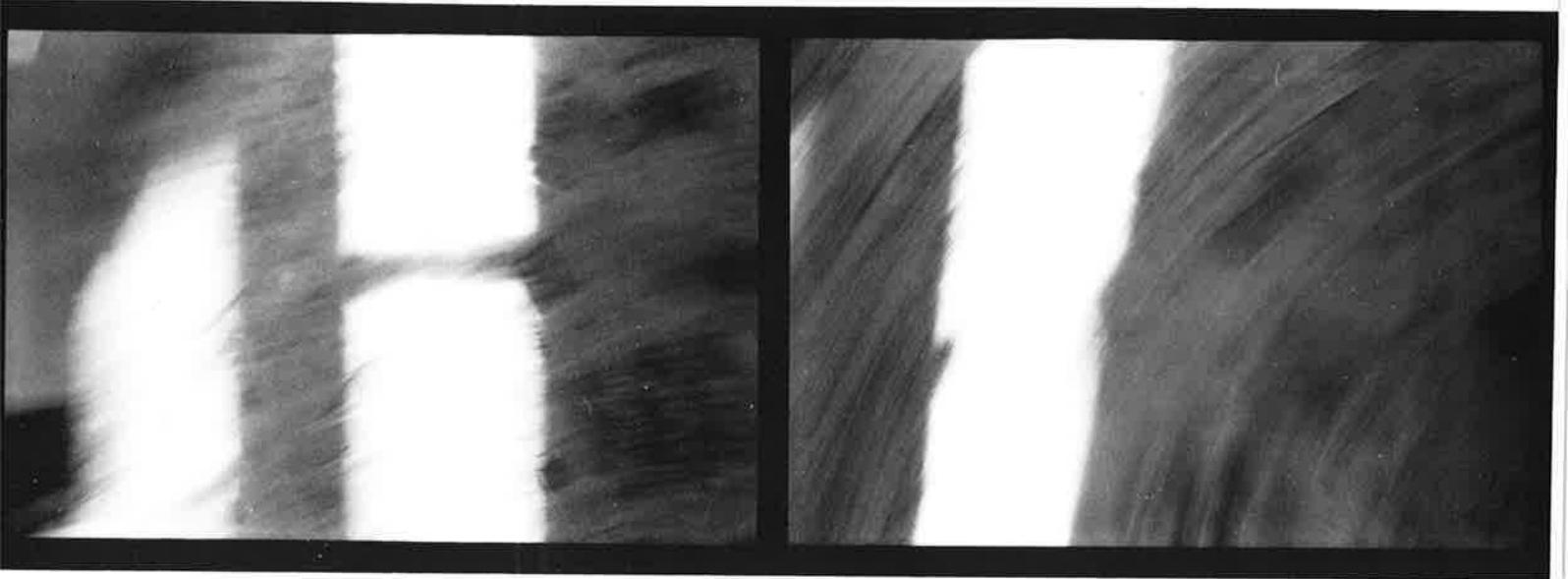

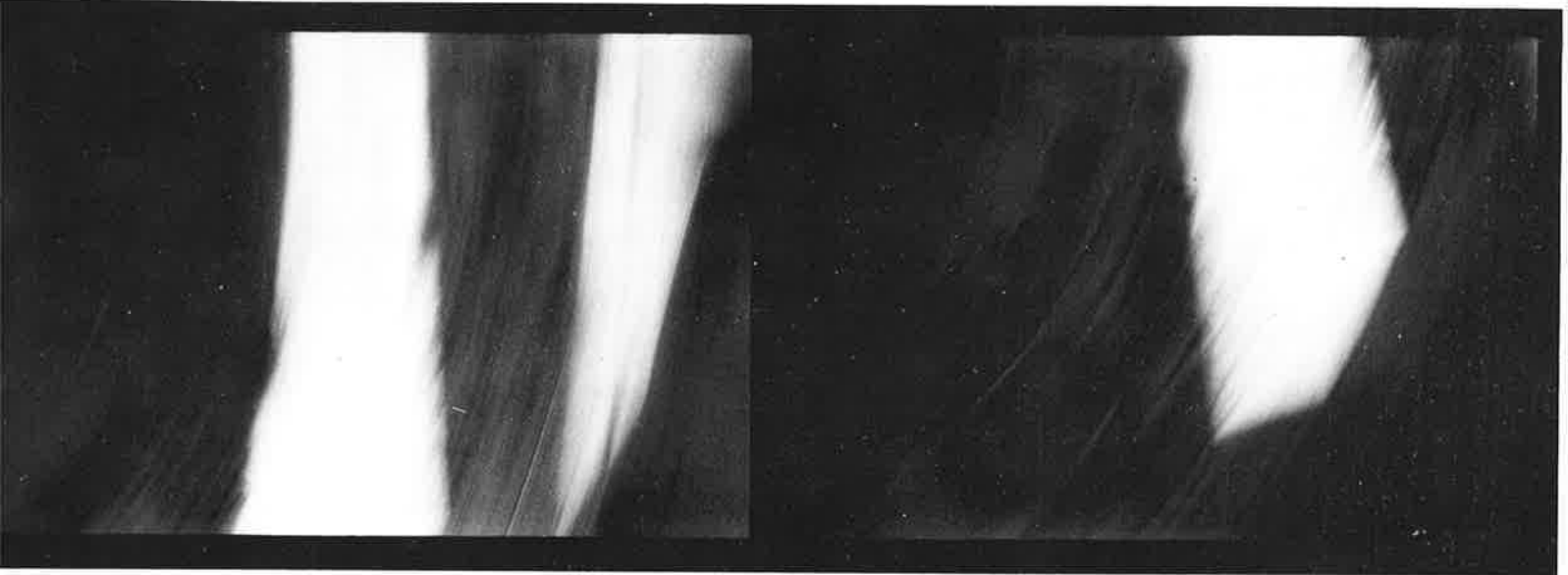
