

TICKETING

All tickets are general admission. Doors to Christ Chapel open one hour prior to the service.

Similar to other major concert venues, tickets should be printed at home and brought to the service to be scanned for entry.

Tickets are non-refundable. To replace a forgotten ticket at the door, please ask an usher for assistance.

PARKING

Many guests attend Christmas in Christ Chapel, so please allow ample time for driving, traffic, parking, and walking to Christ Chapel.

Vehicles will be allowed to drive close to Christ Chapel for drop-off or pick-up only.

Limited disability-accessible parking for people with valid permits is available on the west side of Christ Chapel.

Valet Parking is available thanks to students supporting the Building Bridges Conference. Follow campus signs to the Three Flags site for registration. A donation of \$10 per car is suggested.

SPECIAL NEEDS ASSISTANCE

To ensure the best accommodations for special needs, please allow ample time prior to the service and contact an usher upon arrival. Wheelchair seating will be available at the ends of the pews as space allows. Note: There are NO disability-accessible restrooms in Christ Chapel. The accessible restrooms closest to Christ Chapel are located in the Jackson Campus Center. If there are further questions, please call 507-933-7520.

MEAL OPTIONS

The Christmas Buffet is available prior to each service in the banquet rooms, located in the upper level of the Jackson Campus Center. Buffet tickets are \$25 each. Students may not use their meal plans to pay for buffet tickets. Advance reservations are required due to limited seating.

The Evelyn Young Dining Room is located on the upper level at the north end of the Campus Center. The dining room is served by the Gustavus Adolphus Market Place, which offers a wide selection of food and beverage choices. Items may be purchased there with cash, and students are welcome to use their meal plans for their guests.


OTHER INFORMATION
