A PROVIDER:

Can prescribe medications

- Physicals
- Sore throat (if not improving after 48 hrs)
- Urinary Tract Infection (UTI)
- Depression/ Anxiety
- STD testing
- Pap smears
- Begin birth control/ Talk about options
- Ear ache
- Pink eye (if painful, itchy for 24 hours)
- Mononucleosis
- Bronchitis
- Wart Treatment
- Mole Removal
- Pre- Op visits
- Influenza (rapid onset, aches, chills, high fever)

*Office visits and exams will be billed to your insurance

A NURSE:

Can provide over-thecounter medications

- Immunizations (HPV, Td, Hep A & B, Mantoux)
- General health questions
- Refill birth control if prescribed through Health Service
- Questioning whether to see a provider
- Plan B
- Pregnancy test
- Suture removal
- Sprains
- Abrasions
- Burns
- Rash
- Cold/ Congestion
- Take temperature
- Stomach flu

*Office visits are no charge *Immunizations and labs will be billed to your insurance
