Chem 107 now has a placement exam. You can be placed into 107 (1 semester course) or 106/108 sequence (fall and J-term).

Also require (Senior Year): Humanities or Social Science: upper level course, with an intensive writing requirement, WRITD. (U of M requirement “upper level courses are typically those with a course number of 300 or higher. Writing intensive courses are ones in which writing is an integral part of the course.

Typically, you’re required to complete at least one, 10 page paper.”) U of M accepts a Gustavus 200 or 300 level Humanities or Social Science with the writing component for this requirement. (examples: ENG 253, ENG 317, ENG 321, LAT 302, PHI 202, REL 330, PHI 241, SCA 224, SPA 250)
