- Receive daily Gustavus Announcements via email by 'opting in' to the Gustavus-L.
- Parking permits are required to park a vehicle. Parking is open during the summer. Visitor parking is off limits to employees year round.
- The Campus Safety number is 507-933-8888 or x8888. They are on duty 24 hours a day and are certified first responders.
- Chapel/Sabbath is held daily from 10-10:20am during the academic year. Feel free to attend as your schedule allows.
- Benefit open enrollment occurs annually late October/early November.
