Nice Healthcare is a primary care clinic that offers you and your household unlimited virtual and in-home visits with clinicians.

 - Free X-rays
 - Free physical tests
- Live, virtual physical therapy
- 550+ free medications

WHO CAN USE NICE?

- Any employee of Wings based in MN or WI who is enrolled in the group health plan.
- Those who share the same home address as eligible employees (spouse, children, roommates, partners, etc.)
- Those who are under the age of 65 (Medicare rules prevent Nice from providing care to this population)

Conditions Treated By Nice Healthcare

Acute Conditions:

- Sore throat
- Ear pain, drainage and wax
- Cough, cold, flu, bronchitis and influenza
- Stomach/digestive pain
- Rashes
- 1st degree burns
- Headaches
- Urinary tract infections (UTIs)
- Expedited partner therapy
- Sinus infection
- Yeast infections, bacterial vaginosis
- Minor asthma flares
- Mononucleosis and other viral illnesses

Untreatable Conditions:

- Anything severe or urgent
- Uncontrolled Type 1 diabetes
- Fractures that require casting
- Severe hypertension
- Hyperthyroidism
- Congestive heart failure
- INR/Warfarin monitoring
- Cancer
- Pregnancy management
- Chronic kidney disease
- Hepatitis
- Kidney infection
- Sutures, stitches, staples, skin glue
- Controlled substances
- Allergy shots
- Intravenous medications
- Tuberculosis
- Wound care or dressing changes
- Fertility testing
