## HELPFUL PLANNING

- Designate a Power of Attorney for your financial decisions and a Health Care Proxy for healthcare decisions.
- Create a balance sheet and a record of all accounts, passwords, retirement savings, life insurance policies, and other financial information and review with your spouse, child, or executor regularly.

## RETIREE BENEFITS AT GUSTAVUS

- A retiree from Gustavus is someone who: is age 60 or older; has completed at least 15 years of full-time/benefit-eligible service with the College upon date of retirement; and, has a combined age and years of service with Gustavus Adolphus College equal to or greater than 80.
- All retirees receive the following perks:
  - Guest/Visitor Parking
  - Complimentary access to library privileges, regular season sporting events, concerts, plays, recitals, and a ticket to signature events such as Nobel and Christmas in Christ Chapel
  - Tuition exchange for any eligible dependents
- Additional Faculty Emeriti perks include:
  - Provision for office space at the College where / when possible
  - Participation in all public academic events such as commencement exercises
