ABSTRACT:

The Black Student Organization collection consists of membership information, financial documents, newsletters, event planning materials, and a scrapbook. Contained within the scrapbook are a partial constitution, several news clippings, and numerous member photographs. Most collection materials date from the 1970s.

ORGANIZATION NOTE:

The Black Student Organization (BSO) formed at Gustavus during 1963. By the mid 1970s, members were helping with “recruiting and advising potential black freshmen [and seeing that] . . . new students have the essentials for living on campus such as clothing, books, etc.” BSO members organized activities during Black Consciousness Week and Black History Month. Although the BSO still existed during 1999, the organization’s name and focus changed to the Pan Afrikan Student Organization about 2001.
