Topics include history and legends, land, economics, government, and games, as well as dictionaries. The majority of the collection was created by either the Center of Indian Studies at Black Hills State College, Spearfish, South Dakota or the Lakota Project, Center for the Study of Indigenous Languages of the West in the Department of Linguistics at the University of Colorado, Boulder.
