Introduction

"Out of Scandinavia, a new annual series established to recognize contemporary Nordic writers, will present in its first program noted Saami poet, musician and artist Nils-Aslak Valkeapää." - Gustavus Quarterly

This note explains the need for a list of major works showing us this "forgotten land", presenting its people and their culture.

Since perhaps a thousand authors have already written about the subject, it would be an immense task to compile all of the works. Therefore it was necessary to limit this bibliography to only books in English.

Nevertheless, we have to be aware of all numerous books available in Swedish, Norwegian, Finnish, Russian, Danish and other languages dealing with the subject.

Three sources have been used for the search of the books:

- national bibliographic data base, OCLC
- LUMINA system of the University of Minnesota
- PALS system

Also, several published bibliographies and system indexes were used to find articles and books about Saami. The bibliography is arranged alphabetically.
