

Björling Music Festival Overnight Housing Instructions

1. All high school students will be housed overnight with Gustavus students in dormitory rooms unless permission is granted for special arrangements.
2. Special arrangements must be coordinated through the director of the festival (jpmgwo@gustavus.edu) NO LATER than October 20th. A list of area hotels is available by request. However, Gustavus Adolphus College will not assume responsibility for students staying off campus. Parents/guardians must sign a legal waiver to allow students to stay off campus.
3. All Gustavus students who are hosting BMF students are certified/trained in Title IX and have been instructed as to how to host visitors that are minors.
4. College dorms are at full occupancy. This means that most high school students will be sleeping on the floor, or on a sofa/futon in a dorm room. Please remember to bring a pillow, sleeping bag and/or blanket, and anything else you need to sleep comfortably.
5. In addition to bedding for sleeping arrangements, high school students should also pack:
 - Toiletries
 - Medications
 - Concert attire
 - Casual clothes for rehearsals
 - Pajamas/clothes for sleeping
 - Phone/charger/alarm
 - Instrument and music
