Interpretive Center Building Project

The group has discussed for several years a desire to do some type of building project with the Interpretive Center. The goal is to expand the indoor space in order to accommodate more environmental education for the on campus and off campus communities. With money donated from the Schmidt Foundation the college hired HGA as architect for the pre-design work.

The group contacted environmental learning centers to learn more about their programming and facilities. There was an open house in March to gather input from the community on the project.

There are several factors to consider.

- Even though this has been discussed for years, is there broad enough support for this project.
- What is the future of current Interpretive Center - is the building in sound condition to save and it is the most cost effective to save the building?
- Location - should a new structure be connected to the current building or at least in the same location or not?
- Funding - the arboretum staff and advisory board will need partner with the Advancement Office to raise all the funds for this project. Is this feasible and could money also be raised to increase the Arboretum endowment in conjunction with the building project?
