



## Parking Information

### Facts for PSEO Students bringing a Vehicle to Campus

- Those receiving credit for courses at Gustavus **must** have a valid paid student parking permit to park on campus in designated student (red permit) parking. They cannot park in employee (green permit) or visitor (blue) designated parking.
  - **Visitor Parking Lots are closed to student use at all times. Students parked in Visitor parking will be tracked and cited (\$30 fine each instance), and towed on the 4 th violation at owner's expense.**
  - **Students driving/parking a vehicle on campus with a Green (Employee) sticker will be cited for improper use of permit (\$100 fine).**
  - **Non-registered vehicles cited in any area of campus will be towed after 3 citations.**

### Parking Permit Process

- Students who wish to park a vehicle on campus must register their vehicle with Campus Safety and purchase a student parking permit to display on the vehicle before parking a vehicle.
- Students should visit the Campus Safety office to purchase their parking permit. You will need to provide your license plate and vehicle information, as well as a check for the amount of the permit made out to Gustavus Adolphus College.
- Student parking permits are \$280 and are valid for the entire school year. (Daily permits are also available throughout the year for a fee of \$5/per weekday.) Permits for Spring semester only will be \$140 and available in February.
- Permit holders are responsible for their registered vehicles. It is their responsibility to know and obey all parking rules and regulations. Complete parking and traffic regulations can be found on the Campus Safety web page at <https://gustavus.edu/safety/policies/traffic.php>

### Parking Locations

- Students will be issued a red permit to be able to park in lots posted with red permit parking signs. Students should make themselves familiar with ALL designated Red Permit parking areas, as space is not guaranteed in a particular lot.
- **Visitor Parking Lots are closed to student use at all times.**
